<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> The Amendment is not a separate treaty and, pursuant to Article 20.2 of the Convention, is subject to "ratification, acceptance or approval" by the States Parties to the Convention. Therefore, a State Party to the Convention is free to call the instrument "instrument of ratification", "instrument of acceptance" or "instrument of approval", in accordance with its internal requirements.
