On 9 November 2001, the Republic of Slovenia notified the Depositary of the termination of the application of the Vienna Convention for the Republic of Slovenia and of the Republic of Slovenia's accession to the Paris Convention on Third Party Liability in the Field of Nuclear Energy. Pursuant to Article XXV.2 thereof, the Cienna Convention ceased to apply to Slovenia as of 12 November 2002.
