Professor Ganten World Health Summit, Berlin, Germany

Professor Ganten is a specialist in pharmacology and molecular medicine and is one of the leading scientists worldwide in the field of hypertension. He is the founding president of the World Health Summit, Board Chair of the Charité Foundation and editor of the Journal of Molecular Medicine. Other roles include Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Max Planck Institutes of Colloids and Interfaces and Molecular Plant Physiology (Potsdam-Golm) and Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Ethnological Museum Dahlem of the Prussian Cultural Heritage Foundation. From 2004 to 2008 Professor Ganten was CEO of the Charité Universitätsmedizin Berlin and from 1991 to 2004 Founding Director and CEO of the MaxDelbrück Center for Molecular Medicine.
