DRAFT RESOLUTION ON THE SHARING OF NUCLEAR-SAFETY-RELATED INFORMATION

Draft resolution submitted by Mexico on behalf of the Group of 77

The General Conference, at its special session,

- (a) <u>Recognizing</u> that nuclear power continues to be an important source of energy and is increasingly contributing to electricity generation in a number of countries,
- (b) <u>Recognizing also</u> that nuclear power has a potentially increasing role to play for the developing countries in their social and economic development,
- (c) <u>Convinced</u> that States have the legitimate right to develop and use nuclear energy to meet their growing energy demands,
- (d) <u>Taking</u> note of the common interest of all States in ensuring the safe operation of nuclear power plants and other nuclear facilities everywhere,
- (e) <u>Desiring</u> to strengthen international co-operation in the safe development and use of nuclear energy,

- (f) <u>Appreciating</u> the role of the IAEA in the area of nuclear safety and radiological protection and the usefulness of the Expanded Nuclear Safety Programme contained in document GC(XXX)/777/Add.1, and
- (g) <u>Noting</u> that the sharing of relevant information on nuclear safety for supplied facilities on a continuing, regular and assured basis between the supplier and recipient is a special responsibility of the supplier,
- 1. <u>Urges</u> the supplier States to ensure an uninterrupted supply of relevant information on nuclear safety to the recipient States during the entire operational life of the nuclear facilities supplied by them;
- 2. <u>Decides</u> to intensify efforts by the IAEA in promoting co-operation between States, particularly between supplier and recipient States, on the exchange of relevent information on nuclear safety; and
- 3. Requests the Director General to keep the Board and the General Conference informed about the progress in this regard.
