APPLICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

Application by Senegal

Recommendation by the Board of Governors

1. At a meeting held on 30 September 1960 the following letter addressed to the Director General by the President of the Government of the Republic of Senegal was communicated to the Board:

"320 AE

"14 September 1960

"..... I have the honour, on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Senegal, to apply officially for admission of the Republic of Senegal to full membership of the International Atomic Energy Agency.

"The Government of the Republic of Senegal is willing to carry out all the obligations prescribed by the Statute of the Agency, and to collaborate with the other Members in accordance with the principles of the Charter of the United Nations.

"We are ready to take part at once in the work of the Agency. I should therefore be obliged if you would request the Board of Governors to recommend that the General Conference at its fourth session approve the membership of the Republic of Senegal.

"Immediately on approval, my Government will take the necessary measures to lodge the instrument of acceptance required by Article IV.B of the Statute."

2. The Board considered this application for membership of the Agency in the light of Article IV.B of the Statute, and determined that the Government of Senegal was able and willing to act in accordance with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations. The Board accordingly recommends that the General Conference approve Senegal for membership of the Agency, and submits the draft resolution below for consideration by the General Conference.

APPLICATION BY SENEGAL FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

The General Conference

- (a) Having received the recommendation of the Board of Governors that Senegal should be approved for membership of the Agency,^{1/} and
- (b) Having considered Senegal's application for membership in the light of Article IV.B of the Statute,

Approves Senegal for membership of the Agency.
