CREDENTIALS OF DELEGATES TO THE FOURTH REGULAR SESSION

(b) SECOND REPORT OF THE CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE

Chairman: Mr. S. Yemiscibasi (Turkey)

1. The Credentials Committee held a further meeting on 30 September 1960.
2. The Committee found that seven Member States (El Salvador, Ethiopia, Greece, Honduras, Indonesia, Iran and Morocco) which, at the time the Committee issued its first report,^{1/} had not furnished credentials that satisfied the provisions of Rule 27 of the Rules of Procedure of the General Conference, had in the meantime submitted satisfactory credentials.
3. Two States (Chile and Ghana) which became Member States during the fourth General Conference also submitted credentials in due form.
4. The Committee also noted that four Member States (Brazil, Cuba, Guatemala and Peru) which, at the time the Committee issued its first report had not submitted any credentials, had since submitted provisional credentials for their delegates.
5. The Committee further noted that seven Member States (Albania, Cambodia, Ecuador, Dominican Republic, Haiti, Paraguay and Sudan) were not represented at the fourth regular session of the General Conference.
6. The Committee was informed that the Director General, pursuant to the request which the Committee had made to him on 20 September to arrange with the delegates of certain Member States to obtain satisfactory credentials, had been assured that such credentials for the remaining five delegates which had submitted their credentials in provisional form (Brazil, Cuba, Guatemala, Peru and Venezuela) would be shortly transmitted to him in due form.
