Resolution adopted during the 62nd plenary meeting on 6 October 1961

THE FUNCTIONS OF THE AGENCY'S LABORATORY

The General Conference,

- (a) Recalling the Director General's statement on the completion of the Agency's Laboratory at Seibersdorf,^{1/}
- (b) Noting that use could be made of the unique opportunity thus provided to give international training to a number of scientists of the less-developed areas of the world, and
- (c) Bearing in mind the fact that the work of such trainees could be a valuable contribution to the proper operation of the Laboratory,

Requests the Director General to make available the facilities of the Agency's Laboratory at Seibersdorf, and so to organize its work that as many scientists as possible from the developing areas can receive training, to the extent practicable, in the various fields in which the Laboratory is operating.
