VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE GENERAL FUND FOR 1963

Report of the Committee for Pledges of Voluntary Contributions to the General Fund

Rapportour: Mr. N. KÜRKÇÜOGLU (Turkey)

- 1. The Committee held its fourth meeting on 24 September 1962 under the chairmanship of the President of the General Conference to receive pledges of voluntary contributions of money to the General Fund for 1963. Mr. Kürkçüeglu (Turkey) was unanimously elected Vice-Chairman and Rapporteur.
- 2. Before the announcements of pledges, the Chairman drew the Committee's attention to the Rules Regarding the Acceptance of Voluntary Contributions of Money to the Agency 1.
- 3. A list of the amounts pledged to the General Fund for 1963 during the meeting, subject to such approval of the legislative authorities of each State as may be necessary, is contained in the Annex to the present report. At the meeting, the delegates from Argentina and Ghana announced the intention of their Governments to make known their pledges at a later date.
- 4. The Committee took note of the additional offer of the Government of the United States of America to provide followships and consultant services up to a value of US $\$500\,000^2$, and of the offers of the Governments of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and Poland to provide equipment, followships and expert services in connection with the proposal contained in the draft resolution on a programme of technical assistance to the developing countries introduced by eight States in the Programme, Technical and Budget Committee $\frac{5}{}$.

5. At the conclusion of its meeting, the Committee unanimously decided to recommend to the General Conference the adoption of the following resolution.

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE GENERAL FUND FOR 1963

The General Conference,

Recalling its resolution on the need for increased voluntary contributions to the General Fund, $\frac{1}{2}$

- 1. Takes note of the report of the Committee for Pledges of Voluntary Contributions to the General Fund;
- 2. Expresses its appreciation to those Member States which have pledged voluntary contributions to the General Fund for 1963, noting that certain of those pledges are subject to legislative decision by the authorities concerned;
- 3. Urges all other Member States to contribute to the General Fund in 1963 to the maximum extent compatible with their resources, in order that the Agency's activities in that year shall not be curtailed through lack of funds; and
- 4. Requests the Director General to inform Member States from time to time of additional pleages notified to him after the end of the sixth regular session.
