APPLICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

Application by the Federation of Nigeria

Recommendation by the Board of Governors

1. On 28 May 1963 the following letter addressed to the Director General by the Minister for Foreign Affairs and Commonwealth Relations of the Federation of Nigeria was communicated to the Board:

"UN 11/S4/47

"18 May 1963

"In the name of the Government of the Federation of Nigeria I have the honour to submit an application for membership of the International Atomic Energy Agency.

"I wish to assure you, in the name of my Government, that the Federation of Nigeria is willing to carry out the obligations of membership of the Agency and to act in accordance with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations."

2. On 20 June the Board considered this application for membership of the Agency in the light of Article IV.B of the Statute, and determined that the Federation of Nigeria was able and willing to act in accordance with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations. The Board accordingly recommends that the General Conference approve Nigeria for membership of the Agency and submits the draft resolution below for the consideration of the General Conference.

APPLICATION BY THE FEDERATION OF NIGERIA FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

The General Conference,

- (a) Having received the recommendation of the Board of Governors that the Federation of Nigeria should be approved for membership of the Agency, [1] and
- (b) Having considered Nigeria's application for membership in the light of Article IV.B of the Statute,

Approves the Federation of Nigeria for membership of the Agency.
