ELECTIONS TO THE AGENCY'S STAFF PENSION COMMITTEE

A change in the Committee's composition

Proposal by the Director General

1. Elections to the Agency's Staff Pension Committee were first held in 1958^{1/} within the framework of the Regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund^{2/}, of which the Agency is a Member Organization. So far the Committee has consisted of six members and three alternates chosen, in accordance with Article XX of the Pension Fund's Regulations, in equal number by the General Conference, the Director General and the Agency's staff.
2. Experience has shown, however, that a committee so composed is too small to ensure that a quorum is always obtainable whenever there is business to transact. To overcome this difficulty the Director General proposes that the Committee should be slightly increased in size and should henceforth consist of six members and six alternates chosen in equal number by the General Conference, the Director General and the Agency's staff.
