APPLICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

Application by Algeria

Recommendation by the Board of Governors

1. On 30 September 1963 the following telegram addressed to the Director General by the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Algeria was communicated to the Board:

"2098

"28 SEPTEMBER 1963

"I HAVE THE HONOUR TO REQUEST THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY TO ADMIT ALGERIA AS A MEMBER STATE ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF ALGERIA. I WISH TO ASSURE THE AGENCY OF ALGERIA'S WILLINGNESS TO FULFIL THE OBLIGATIONS INCUMBENT ON MEMBERS OF THE AGENCY UNDER THE TERMS OF ITS STATUTE AND THE AIMS AND PRINCIPLES OF THE UNITED NATIONS CHARTER."

2. On 1 October the Board considered this application for membership of the Agency in the light of Article IV.B of the Statute, and determined that Algeria was able and willing to act in accordance with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations. The Board accordingly recommends that the General Conference approve Algeria for membership of the Agency and submits the draft resolution overleaf for the consideration of the General Conference.

APPLICATION BY ALGERIA FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

The General Conference,

(a) Having received the recommendation by the Board of Governors that Algeria should be approved for membership of the Agency,^{1/}
and

(b) Having considered this application for membership in the light of Article IV.B of the Statute,

Approves Algeria for membership of the Agency.
