ELECTION OF MEMBERS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS

Memorandum by the Director General

1. Under Rule 86 of the Rules of Procedure^{1/} the General Committee is called upon both to determine the number of elective places on the Board of Governors which must be filled by the General Conference, as well as to specify each geographical area in respect of which a Member or Members must be elected so as to ensure compliance with the provisions of Article VI.A.3 of the Statute.
2. In accordance with that Article and Rule, the Board must henceforth include 12 Members elected by the Conference. The current amended text of the Article has, however, come into force^{2/} since the Conference held elections to the Board last year, and there are thus only ten elected Members at present serving on the Board.
3. Of these ten, the terms of office of five - Colombia, Greece, Hungary, Pakistan and Viet-Nam - will expire at the end of the present session^{3/}. The Committee will, therefore, no doubt wish to determine and so report to the Conference that seven Members must be elected to the Board during this session.
4. Article VI.A.3 of the Statute provides that the Members of the Board elected by the General Conference shall always include:

3 from Latin America, 1 from South Asia,
1 from Western Europe, 1 from South East Asia and
1 from Eastern Europe, the Pacific; and
3 from Africa and the Middle East, 1 from the Far East.

Since the five elected Members that will continue to serve on the Board after the end of the current session are Brazil, Indonesia, Iran, Italy and Mexico^{4/}, the Committee will doubtless wish to specify that the following elections are required in respect of geographical areas:

1 from Latin America, 1 from South Asia, and
1 from Eastern Europe, 1 from the Far East.
2 from Africa and the Middle East,

5. For the Committee's convenience, a draft of its report to the Conference is annexed hereto. The draft follows the lines, mutatis mutandis, of the corresponding reports the Committee has made to the Conference in the past^{5/}.

ELECTION OF MEMBERS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS

Report by the General Committee

1. Rule 86 of the Rules of Procedure^{1/} requires the General Committee to determine the number of elective places on the Board of Governors which must be filled by the General Conference so as to ensure compliance with the provisions of Article VI.A.3 of the Statute. The Committee accordingly notifies the Conference that it has determined that seven Members must be elected to the Board during the present session. In this connection the Committee invites attention to the last provision in the Article, which stipulates that

"... no member in this category [of members elected to the Board by the General Conference] in any one term of office will be eligible for re-election in the same category for the following term of office."^{2/}

2. Rule 86 further requires the General Committee to specify the geographical areas in respect of which a Member or Members must be elected so as to ensure that after the end of the session the Board shall include three Members elected by the General Conference from each of the areas of Latin America and of Africa and the Middle East, and one Member from each of the remaining areas, except North America, specified in Rule 83. In compliance with this provision, the Committee hereby specifies that elections are required at the current session in respect of five geographical areas, as follows:

The remaining Member may be elected from any geographical area in so far as its election is not precluded by the provisions of Article VI of the Statute.

3. In view of the provision in Rule 83 that the General Conference shall conduct the elections with due regard to equitable representation on the Board as a whole of the Members in the geographical areas specified in that Rule, it may wish to have before it the following list of Members that have already been designated by the Board^{3/} or elected by the General Conference^{4/} to serve on the Board after the end of the present session:
