CREREDENTIALS OF DELEGATES TO THE EIGHTH REGULAR SESSION OF THE GENERAL CONFERENCE

The General Conference

(a) Recalling the recommendation of the fifth regular session of the General Assembly of the United Nations on 14 December 1950 that "the attitude adopted by the General Assembly" regarding the representation of a Member State "should be taken into account in other organs of the United Nations and in the specialized agencies,"^{1/} and

(b) Recalling the action which the eighteenth regular session of the General Assembly took on 21 October 1963 regarding the representation of China,^{2/}

1. Decides to take no action on any proposal to change the representation of China at its eighth regular session; and
2. Finds that the credentials of the delegate of the Government of the Republic of China conform with the provisions of Rule 27 of the Rules of Procedure.
