APPLICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

Application by Sierra Leone

Recommendation by the Board of Governors

1. On 22 September 1966 the following telegram sent by the Permanent Secretary of the Development Office of Sierra Leone, on behalf of the Prime Minister, was communicated to the Board:

"218

"20 September 1966

"GOVERNMENT SIERRA LEONE HAS THE HONOUR TO APPLY FOR MEMBERSHIP OF AGENCY AND ACCEPTS RESPONSIBILITY AND OBLIGATION IMPOSED ON IT BY STATUTE"

2. On 23 September the Board considered this application for membership in the light of Article IV.B of the Statute, and determined that Sierra Leone was able and willing to act in accordance with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations. The Board accordingly recommends that the General Conference approve Sierra Leone for membership of the Agency, and submits the draft resolution below for the consideration of the Conference.

APPLICATION BY SIERRA LEONE FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

The General Conference,

- (a) Having received the recommendation of the Board of Governors that Sierra Leone should be approved for membership of the Agency,^{1/} and
- (b) Having considered Sierra Leone's application for membership in the light of Article IV.B of the Statute,

Approves Sierra Leone for Membership of the Agency.
