SCALE OF MEMBERS' CONTRIBUTIONS FOR 1968

Memorandum by the Director General

1. The Director General submits herewith a draft resolution whereby the General Conference could set the scale for assessment of Members' contributions to the Agency's Regular Budget for 1968. Following current practice [1], the scale is based on the United Nations scale for 1967 [2]. It takes account of the fact that two additional States (Sierra Leone and Singapore) have become Members of the Agency since the Conference set the scale for the current year [3], and that Honduras has withdrawn from the Agency. Thus, 97 States were Members of the Agency on 31 August 1967. [4]

2. Numerical data used in elaborating the scale are reproduced in the Annex to the present document. The procedure that would be followed for assessing the contribution of any State that became a Member of the Agency after the scale had been adopted is set out in paragraph 2 of the draft resolution.

1. Decides that the scale for assessment of Members' contributions to the Agency's Regular Budget for the year 1968 shall be as follows:

Decides further that any State that becomes a Member of the Agency during the remainder of 1967 or in 1968 shall be assessed as appropriate for contributions to the Agency's Regular Budget for these years, and for its advance to the Working Capital Fund, by applying to its United Nations percentage the appropriate coefficient used to determine the scales for assessment of Members' contributions for 1967 and 1968.

B. Method of calculating the coefficient 0.900

1. From the foregoing table it will be noted that on the United Nations scale for 1967, the total percentage assessments of Members of the Agency that are also Members of the United Nations amounts to 98.93. The assessments recommended by the United Nations for the Agency's Members that are not Members of the United Nations amount to 8.58%, making a total of 107.51%.

2. It has therefore been necessary to establish a coefficient by which to multiply the assessments so as to decrease the total to 100.00%, bearing in mind that in the light of a decision of the General Conference [1], it will not be applied:

- (a) In the case of the following 28 Members that bear the minimum rate of assessment of 0.04%, and whose assessments accordingly total 1.12%:
