Memorandum by the Director General

1. By noon on 20 September 1968 Members of the Agency had pledged the following voluntary contributions to the General Fund for 1969:

2. It is foreseen that the Conference will take the matter of voluntary contributions to the General Fund in a plenary meeting at which the President will invite attention to the list of contributions pledged in advance, and revisions of the present memorandum will be issued for the purpose of keeping the Conference informed of the growth in the total value of the pledges made.

The delegates of Members that have not yet pledged a contribution to the General Fund for 1969 are accordingly invited to communicate their Governments' pledges as soon as possible to the officer who will be sitting during plenary meetings at a table marked "Voluntary Contributions" near the foot of the podium in the Festsaal, and who will be at a table similarly identified in the Zeremoniensaal at other times.
