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SCALE OF ASSESSMENT OF MEMBERS' CONTRIBUTIONS FOR 1976

Memorandum by the Director General

1. The Director General submits herewith to the General Conference a draft of a resolution whereby the Conference could set the scale of assessment of Members' contributions to the Agency's Regular Budget for 1976. The scale annexed to the resolution has been prepared in accordance with the principles which the Conference established in 1959 and supplemented with further principles in 1971 [1]. The scale is based on membership as of 31 July 1975, which includes two States, the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and Mauritius, that became Members during the past year.
2. It will be noted that the resolution would also provide for approval by the General Conference of the base rate of assessment for each Member. This has been derived from the scale used by the United Nations to assess contributions from its Members to its regular budget for 1975, adjusted to compensate for differences in membership between the Agency and the United Nations.
3. The computations that had to be made in order to establish both the individual base rates and the resulting scale of assessment are reproduced for the information of the Conference in the Appendix hereto.

Draft resolution

SCALE OF ASSESSMENT OF MEMBERS' CONTRIBUTIONS FOR 1976

The General Conference,

Applying the principles it has established for the assessment of Members' contributions towards the Agency's administrative expenses [*],

1. Decides that the individual base rates and the resulting scale of assessment of Members' contributions to the Agency's Regular Budget for 1976 shall be as set forth in the Annex hereto; and

2. Determines, pursuant to Financial Regulation 6.08 [**], that in the event of a State becoming a Member of the Agency during the remainder of 1975 or in 1976, it shall be assessed as appropriate:

- (a) For an advance or advances to the Working Capital Fund, in accordance with Financial Regulation 7.03 [***]; and
- (b) For a contribution or contributions towards the Agency's administrative expenses, in accordance with the principles the Conference has established for that purpose.

APPENDIX

MEMBERS' CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE AGENCY'S REGULAR BUDGET FOR 1976

The computation of individual base rates and the resulting scale of assessment

1. The first step in computing the individual base rates and the resulting scale of assessment of Members' contributions to the Agency's Regular Budget for the year 1976 consists of dividing the total amount to be assessed into a "non-safeguards" component and a "safeguards" component [1]. The total assessment proposed is \$34 237 000 [2], of which the non-safeguards and safeguards components are \$27 372 000 and \$6 865 000 respectively. The latter component consists of the appropriation specifically proposed for safeguards (\$6 443 000), plus \$427 000 representing a pro rata share of the appropriation for adjustment of programme cost estimates [3], and less income of \$5000 which it is estimated will be received from non-member States during 1976.
2. The next step is to derive a base rate of assessment for each Member of the Agency [4] from the scale used by the United Nations to assess contributions from its Members to its budgets for the years 1974-76 [5]. In line with the instructions that the General Assembly of the United Nations gave to its Committee on Contributions in 1972 [6], this requires in the first place the determination of the base rate of the largest contributor to the Agency's Regular Budget, the United States of America, by reducing its base rate for 1975 (27.66%) by the total of the rates of assessment set by the United Nations for the two States, the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (0.07%) and Mauritius (0.02%), that became Members of the Agency during the past year. This gives a base rate of 27.57% for the United States. The calculation of the base rates for 1976 of the other Members is shown in Table 1 below; the computation of the coefficient used in column 4 of the Table is explained in paragraph 3. It will thus be seen, by comparing Table 1 with the corresponding table for 1975 [7], that only the base rate of the United States has changed, as a result of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and Mauritius having become Members of the Agency.

3. It will be seen from the end of the foregoing table that the United Nations percentage assessments for Members of the Agency that are also Members of the United Nations amount to 93.78%, and that the United Nations rates of assessment for the other Members of the Agency amount to 1.22%. To the figure of 95.00% obtained by combining these two percentages a coefficient is applied to establish such base rates of assessment for all Members of the Agency as will give a total of 100.00%. In accordance with a principle established by the General Conference, however, the coefficient is not applied in the case of the Member bearing the United Nations highest assessment, nor of the 37 Members each bearing the United Nations lowest assessment [8]. The coefficient is therefore calculated as follows:

4. It is now necessary to calculate the respective shares of the safeguards expenses to be borne by the Members on a list drawn up for the purpose by the Director General [9]. The results are presented in Table 2 below.

5. It will be noted from the foregoing table that a total of 72 Members will be required to contribute \$353 236 (5.14546%) of the total safeguards component of \$6 865 000 [10]. The remaining \$6 511 764 (94.85454%) will need to be borne by 34 Members, the shares of each being calculated as shown in the following table [11].

6. The individual share of each Member in the safeguards component of the total assessment having thus been determined, the next step is to calculate each Member's share of the non-safeguards component. This is done in Table 4 below [12] which shows in column (5) the consequent total assessment of each Member. Column (6) gives the resulting scale of assessment for 1976, the percentage assessments being expressed to five places of decimals in order to reflect each Member's share of the Regular Budget with the required accuracy.
