INVITATION TO THE PALESTINE LIBERATION ORGANIZATION
TO ATTEND THE SESSIONS OF THE
GENERAL CONFERENCE AS AN OBSERVER

## The General Conference,

- (a) Having considered the item "Invitation to the Palestine Liberation Organization to attend the sessions of the General Conference in the capacity of an observer",
- (b) Guided by the many resolutions adopted by the General Assembly of the United Nations and in particular Resolution 3237(XXIX) "Observer Status for the Palestine Liberation Organization" which, among other things "Considers that the Palestine Liberation Organization is entitled to participate as an observer in the sessions and the work of all international conferences convened under the auspices of other organs of the United Nations",
- (c) Noting that many international organizations such as the World Health Organization (WHO), the International Labour Organisation (ILO), the World Meteorological Organization (WMO), the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) and the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) have accorded observer status to the Palestine Liberation Organization, and
- (d) Noting also that the Palestine Liberation Organization has been widely recognized as the representative of the people of Palestine who have the right to live, as a nation, in their homeland Palestine,
- 1. <u>Decides</u> to invite the Palestine Liberation Organization to participate, as an observer, in this session and in all future sessions and meetings of the General Conference; and
- 2. Requests the Director General to take the necessary steps for the implementation of this resolution.
