The General Conference elected the following 12 Members to the Board of Governors to hold office until the end of the twenty-third regular session in 1979:

Ecuador and Peru	for Latin America;
Austria and Norway	for Western Europe;
Bulgaria and Romania	for Eastern Europe;
Ghana and Tunisia	for Africa;
Kuwait	for the Middle East and South Asia;
Korea, Republic of	for the Far East;
Iran	for Middle East and South Asia, South East Asia and the Pacific, or the Far East; and
Senegal [1]	for Africa, the Middle East and South Asia, or South East Asia and the Pacific
