

The General Conference suspended for the twenty-second regular session the relevant part of Rule 40 of its Rules of Procedure [1] to permit the election of six additional members. It elected the delegates of the Federal Republic of Germany, the German Democratic Republic, India, Jamaica, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and the United States of America as additional Members of the General Committee, and duly appointed the Committee for the twenty-second regular session.
