Resolution adopted during the 256th plenary meeting on 14 October 1983

THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE PHYSICAL PROTECTION OF NUCLEAR MATERIAL

The General Conference,

- (a) Recalling the resolutions adopted at its nineteenth and twenty-first regular sessions regarding the physical protection of nuclear materials,[1]
 - (b) Recalling the adoption in October 1979 of the Convention on the Physical Protection of Nuclear Material, and
 - (c) Noting that to date there are 37 signatories and eight ratifications of the Convention,
1. Expresses the hope that the Convention will enter into force at the earliest possible date and that it will obtain the widest possible adherence; and
 2. Requests the Director General to report to the General Conference at its next regular session on the signature and ratification status of the Convention.
