

The General Conference suspended the relevant parts of Rules 34 and 40 of its Rules of Procedure in order to permit the election of six Vice-Presidents. It elected the delegates of Guatemala, Norway, Saudi Arabia, Tunisia, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and the United States of America as Vice-Presidents of the General Conference, to hold office until the close of the thirty-second regular session.
