# MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN INTERNATIONAL CO-OPERATION IN MATTERS RELATING TO NUCLEAR SAFETY AND RADIOLOGICAL PROTECTION

### Resolution adopted during the 321st plenary meeting on 29 September 1989

#### **DUMPING OF NUCLEAR WASTES**

#### The General Conference,

- (a) Recalling resolution GC(XXXII)/RES/490, which among other things requests the Director General of the Agency to establish a representative technical working group of experts with the objective of elaborating an internationally agreed code of practice for international transactions involving nuclear wastes based on, inter alia, a review of current national and international laws and regulations on waste disposal, and
- (b) <u>Taking note</u> of the report by the Director General contained in document GC(XXXIII)/883,
- 1. <u>Expresses its appreciation</u> to the Technical Working Group of Experts for the work done during its first meeting on the contents and structure of a Code of Practice for transboundary movements of radioactive wastes;
- 2. <u>Expresses the hope</u> that the Working Group will complete its task in time for submission of a draft Code of Practice on Radioactive Waste Transactions to the General Conference at its thirty-fourth (1990) regular session;
- 3. Requests the Director General to continue to extend all facilities and assistance to the Working Group in order to facilitate its work; and
- 4. <u>Further requests</u> the Director General to report through the Board of Governors to the General Conference at its thirty-fourth regular session on the implementation of this resolution.
