The General Conference,

Accepting the recommendations of the Board of Governors relating to the Regular Budget of the Agency for 1994 ½,

1. <u>Appropriates</u> on the basis of an exchange rate of AS 12.70 to \$1.00, an amount of \$200 103 000 for the Regular Budget expenses of the Agency in 1994 as follows:

- 2. <u>Decides</u> that the foregoing appropriation shall be financed, after the deduction of
- revenues deriving from Reimbursable Work for Others (Section 8); and
- other miscellaneous income of \$2 955 000 (representing \$1 815 000 plus AS 14 478 000);

from contributions by Member States amounting, for an exchange rate of AS 12.70 to \$1.00, to \$192 063 000 (\$25 782 000 plus the equivalent in US dollars of AS 2 111 769 000), in accordance with the scale of assessment fixed by the General Conference in resolution GC(XXXVII)/RES/613, each contribution to be adjusted in the light of the rate applicable at the date of receipt; and

3. <u>Authorizes</u> the Director General:

- (a) To incur expenditures additional to those for which provision is made in the Regular Budget for 1994, provided that the relevant emoluments of any staff involved and all other costs are entirely financed from revenues arising out of sales, work performed for Member States or international organizations, research grants, special contributions or other sources extraneous to the Regular Budget for 1994; and
- (b) With the prior approval of the Board of Governors, to make transfers between any of the Sections listed in paragraph 1 above.

For the financing of Nuclear Power, Nuclear Fuel Cycle and Waste Management, Nuclear Safety and Scientific and Technical Information.

For the financing of Unallocated Publishing Services and Unallocated Data Processing Central Services.

For the financing of Food and Agriculture, Life Sciences, Physical and Chemical Sciences, the International Centre for Theoretical Physics (in part) and the IAEA Marine Environment Laboratory - Monaco (in part).
