AN AFRICAN NUCLEAR-WEAPON-FREE ZONE

Resolution adopted on 23 September 1994, during the ninth plenary meeting

AN AFRICAN NUCLEAR-WEAPON-FREE ZONE

The General Conference,

- (a) Recalling resolution GC(XXXVII)/RES/625 of 1993 and all other relevant resolutions and decisions of the General Conference and the Board of Governors, and
- (b) Welcoming the progress made towards the conclusion of a treaty on an African Nuclear-Weapon-Free Zone, on the basis of the Declaration on the Denuclearization of Africa, adopted by the Summit of the Organization of African Unity (OAU) at its first ordinary session, held in Cairo from 17 to 21 July 1964, and of resolution A/RES/48/86 adopted on 16 December 1993 by the General Assembly of the United Nations,
- 1. <u>Takes note</u> of the report of the Director General on the establishment of an African Nuclear-Weapon-Free Zone, contained in document GC(XXXVIII)/13;
- 2. <u>Commends</u> the African States for their efforts towards the establishment of an African Nuclear-Weapon-Free Zone and requests the Director General to continue to assist them in this regard; and
- 3. <u>Requests</u> the Director General to report on the implementation of this resolution to the General Conference at its thirty-ninth regular session under an agenda item entitled "An African Nuclear-Weapon-Free Zone".
