Resolution adopted on 23 September 1994, during the ninth plenary meeting

## THE PARTICIPATION OF SOUTH AFRICA IN THE ACTIVITIES OF THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY

## The General Conference,

- (a) <u>Bearing in mind</u> the provisions of the Statute of the International Atomic Energy Agency,
- (b) Recalling resolutions GC(XX)/RES/336 of 1976, GC(XXVII)/RES/408 of 1983, GC(XXIX)/RES/442 of 1985 and GC(XXX)/RES/468 of 1986 regarding South Africa's participation in the activities of the Agency,
- (c) Taking into account recent resolutions and decisions of the United Nations and its specialized agencies, including resolution 919 (1994) adopted by the Security Council and resolution A/RES/48/258A of 23 June 1994 adopted by the General Assembly of the United Nations and welcoming South Africa back into the United Nations family,
- (d) <u>Noting</u> that South Africa, as a result of her dismantling her nuclear weapons programme, has contributed to the evolution of an African nuclear-weapon-free zone, thus enhancing the promotion of peaceful uses of nuclear energy in Africa, and
- (e) <u>Welcoming with deep satisfaction</u> the new Government of National Unity in South Africa as representative of all the peoples of that country,

- 1. <u>Invites</u> South Africa to resume participation in all activities of the Agency;
- 2. <u>Requests</u> the Board of Governors to review the designation of South Africa to the Board in the light of the preceding new developments; and
- 3. <u>Further requests</u> the Board of Governors to submit a report to the General Conference at its thirty-ninth regular session on this matter.
