Text of communication dated 27 June 2004 received from the Permanent Mission of Kazakhstan concerning restoration of voting rights

PERMANENT MISSION OF THE REPUBLIC OF KAZAKHSTAN TO THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS IN VIENNA

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Kazakhstan to the International Organizations in Vienna presents its compliments to the Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency and has the honour to request the restoration of its voting rights on the basis of a Payment Plan Agreement which was concluded between the Government of Kazakhstan and the IAEA in 2001 to settle its Regular Budget arrears within a period of five years.

The Republic of Kazakhstan is currently in the fourth year of this Payment Plan and fulfilled its financial obligations according to terms of the Plan.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Kazakhstan to the International Organizations in Vienna avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the IAEA Secretariat the assurances of its highest consideration.
