Text of communication received on 20 July 2004 from the Permanent Mission of the Republic of Armenia concerning restoration of voting rights

The text of a letter received on 20 July 2004 from the Permanent Mission of Armenia and addressed to the Director General is reproduced herewith for the attention of the General Conference.

## PERMANENT MISSION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA TO THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY

I am writing to inform you that the Republic of Armenia has fulfilled its commitments towards the International Atomic Energy Agency and has paid the second instalment according to the payment plan as agreed with the Secretariat in 11.07.2003., ref. N3.31.2-ARM, as well as the contribution to the regular budget for 2004.

The 47<sup>th</sup> General Conference, taking into account the approved payment plan and Armenia's desire to restore the voting right, decided to restore the voting right for and during that particular conference, the 47<sup>th</sup>.

On behalf of the Government of Armenia I would like to ask you to consider at the 48<sup>th</sup> General Conference the restoration of its voting right with the full, immediate and continual effect.
