The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Uzbekistan to the International Organizations in Vienna presents its compliments to the Director General of the International Atomic Energy Agency and has the honour to inform that the Government of the Republic of Uzbekistan remains committed to fulfilling its financial obligations to the IAEA, and in this regard, concluded a ten year Payment Plan Agreement, starting in 2009, to pay off its arrears to the regular budget.

Under the terms of the Payment Plan Agreement the Government of the Republic of Uzbekistan has fulfilled its financial obligations for the year 2010 and will continue to meet its financial obligations in the years ahead.

On the basis of these commitments and the recent payments, the Government of the Republic of Uzbekistan requests the restoration of its voting rights at the Agency.

The Permanent Mission avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Director General of IAEA the assurances of its highest consideration.
