The Libyan Embassy/Permanent Mission in Vienna presents its compliments to the esteemed General Committee of the International Atomic Energy Agency, and hereby requests restoration of the voting rights of the State of Libya during the forthcoming 62th Regular Session of the General Conference, to be held in Vienna from 17-19/9/2018.

As is well known, the State of Libya has been undergoing financial difficulties in view of the critical and unstable security situation occurring since a long time.

Despite the above, the State of Libya paid at the beginning of this year an amount of 435,633 Euros, which represented 432,047 Euros as its contribution towards the 2014 regular budget of the Agency, and 3,586 Euros towards the 2015 regular budget. Once the situation permits, the State of Libya will transfer the remaining arrears for the years 2015-2018.

The Libyan Embassy /Permanent Mission in Vienna avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the esteemed General Committee of the International Atomic Energy Agency the assurances of its highest consideration.
