5. Arrangements for the Conference

(GC(64)/12 and Add.1; GC(64)/INF/12, 13 and 16)

(a) Adoption of the agenda and allocation of items for initial discussion

1. The PRESIDENT said that the General Committee had recommended that the agenda for the sixty-fourth session consist of all items listed in the provisional agenda set out in document GC(64)/1 and all of the supplementary items set out in documents GC(64)/1/Add.1 and Add.2. The Committee had also taken note that, under item 8 of the provisional agenda, the Plenary had adopted the draft resolution contained in document GC(64)/L.2 entitled The IAEA and the COVID-19 Pandemic. With regard to the allocation of items for initial discussion, the Committee had recommended that the items listed in documents GC(64)/1 and Add.1 and 2 be taken up for discussion as indicated in those documents. It had also recommended that the order of items set out in those documents be followed.

(b) Closing date of the session and opening date of the next session

3. The PRESIDENT said that the General Committee had recommended that the Conference set Friday, 25 September 2020, as the closing date of the sixty-fourth regular session, and Monday, 20 September 2021, as the opening date of the sixty-fifth regular session.
