## INSTRUMENTS CONCLUDED BY THE AGENCY IN CONNECTION WITH ARTICLE 13 OF THE TREATY FOR THE PROHIBITION OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS IN LATIN AMERICA[1]

The text of the Protocol with Uruguay

- 1. The text[2] of the Protocol between the Eastern Republic of Uruguay and the Agency in connection with Article 13 of the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America[3] for the application of safeguards thereunder is reproduced in this document for the information of all Members.
- 2. Members will be informed of the entry into force of the Protocol by an addendum to this document.

## PROTOCOL BETWEEN THE EASTERN REPUBLIC OF URUGUAY AND THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY IN CONNECTION WITH ARTICLE 13 OF THE TREATY FOR THE PROHIBITION OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS IN LATIN AMERICA

WHEREAS the Eastern Republic of Uruguay (hereinafter called "Uruguay") is a party to the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America (hereinafter called "the Tlatelolco Treaty"), Article 13 of which provides, inter alia, that "Each Contracting Party shall negotiate multilateral or bilateral agreements with the International Atomic Energy Agency for the application of its safeguards to its nuclear activities....";

WHEREAS Uruguay is also a party to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons[4] and on 24 September 1971 concluded an agreement with the International Atomic Energy Agency (hereinafter called "the Agency") for the application of safeguards in connection with that Treaty (hereinafter called "the Safeguards Agreement")[5];

WHEREAS Uruguay considers that the Safeguards Agreement covers its obligations under Article 13 of the Tlatelolco Treaty;

NOW, THEREFORE, Uruguay and the Agency have agreed as follows:

- 1. The safeguards set forth in the Safeguards Agreement shall also apply, as regards Uruguay, in connection with the Tlatelolco Treaty.
- 2. If the Safeguards Agreement ceases to be in force, an agreement shall be concluded for the continued application of safeguards by the Agency in connection with the Tlatelolco Treaty. Until the entry into force of such an agreement safeguards shall continue to be applied in Uruguay on the same terms as set forth in the Safeguards Agreement.
- 3. This Protocol shall enter into force on the same date as the Safeguards Agreement and shall remain in force as long as Uruguay is a party to the Tlatelolco Treaty.
